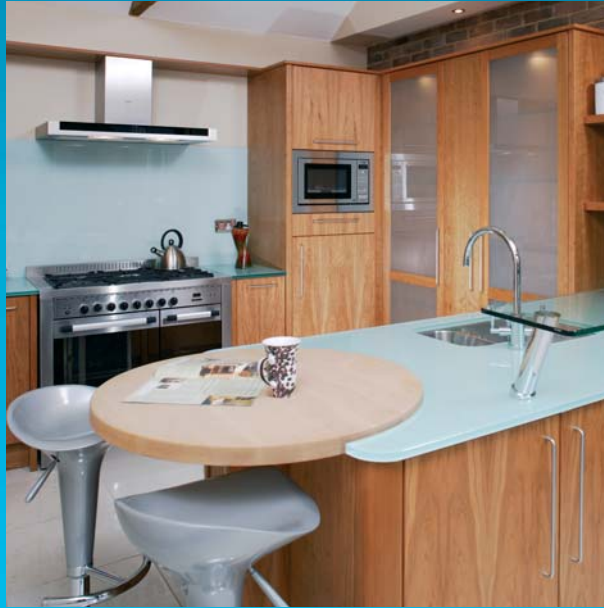

Work-surfaces

Glass work surfaces are proving to be an interesting alternative to granite, wood or marble in the kitchen or bathroom. Counter tops and splash backs in both clear and coloured glass in any shape or size can be incorporated into your kitchen. With the latest CNC technology we can accommodate sink cut outs together with drainage grooves to give an extra prestigious finish.



Glass worktops are typically manufactured from 19mm thick toughened glass. Glass worktops can be supplied in any colour but generally most colours can be chosen from the RAL coding system

The glass used is an optically clear glass which means that the normal green tinge of annealed glass is substantially reduced. This has an added benefit of giving the chosen colour a more true definition.

Splash-backs

Splash backs in glass are an effective alternative to tiles or other forms of wall covering. They require less labour to install and hold many benefits over conventional wall coverings, ease of cleaning being one advantage.

As with glass work surfaces, splash backs are produced using similar methods. They are typically produced using 6mm toughened optically clear glass and can give even the most dated kitchen a cost effective contemporary makeover. Again, colours can be chosen from the RAL coding system or matched to the current décor of the interior.

Most shapes can be accommodated so that even the most tricky shower enclosure or kitchen wall can be covered. CNC technology allows us to create cut outs for plug sockets as well as fixing cut outs for other equipment such as showers or cabinets.

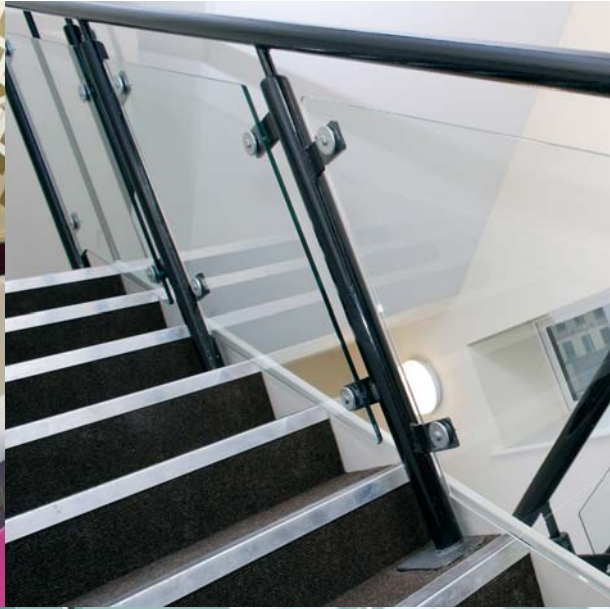


Lead Times (based on an Ex-Works basis for supply only)
